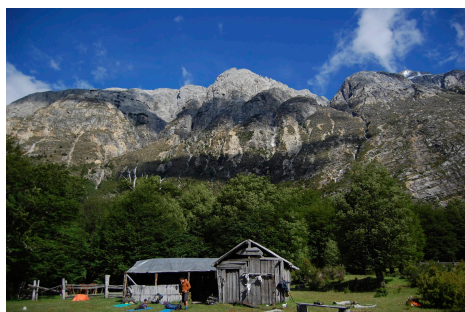


### Course Info

**Cost:** Includes national flight in Chile, travel, food, lodging, fees, NAU tuition (3 credits), camp gear, evacuation and int'l medical insurance. \$3919

An interdisciplinary, experiential opportunity designed for students seeking exciting new ways to learn and engage with the NAU curriculum. Students will be engaged with biology, environmental science, politics, culture, sustainability, systems thinking, and service work while living in the backcountry of Patagonia, Chile for three weeks.
